### DIRECTIONS TO UC SANTA CRUZ

UC Santa Cruz is located at the northern tip of Monterey Bay on the California coast, 75 miles south of San Francisco.

#### From the South:

Take Route 101 north to 156 west to Route 1 north to Santa Cruz.

#### From the North:

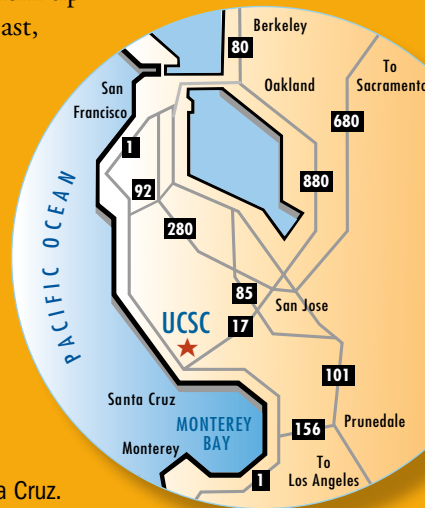
Take Route 5 south to 80 west to Route 680 south to 280 north. Then take Highway 17 south to Route 1 north to Santa Cruz.

#### From San Francisco Airport:

Take Route 101 south to 85 south to Highway 17 south to Route 1 north to Santa Cruz.

#### From San Jose Airport:

Take Route 880 south to Highway 17 south to Route 1 north to Santa Cruz.



**Once you're in Santa Cruz on Route 1 north:** Route 1 will become Mission Street. Turn right off Mission onto Bay Street and follow it through the campus entrance. Follow the signs to designated "Scholarship Dinner" parking.
