

Parking, Transportation & Circulation during Construction at the Bookstore & College Nine Apartments

Affected Parking Lots

#102 - Baytree Bookstore

Most permit and meter parking spaces will be eliminated in August 1998 to accommodate the new Bookstore and Graduate Commons buildings.

#103 - East Field House

Some permit spaces will be converted to meter spaces to accommodate visitors to OPERS, the Bookstore, and Whole Earth.

#104 - East Remote

Attendant parking will be increased to accommodate more student, staff and faculty parking.

#165 - College 9 Apartments

Most of this lot will be closed for approximately 18 months beginning August 1998 during the construction of the College Nine Apartments.

Affected Roadways

Bookstore Area - Hagar Drive

Hagar Drive between Steinhart and McLaughlin will be a northbound one-way road during the Bookstore/Graduate Commons construction period (20 months beginning August 1998).

Affected Pedestrian Circulation

Bookstore Area

During the Bookstore construction period the following pedestrian paths will be closed: Classroom Unit/Bookstore Lot; McLaughlin/Bookstore Parking Lot; Tunnel between Quarry and North side of McLaughlin. Pedestrian access will be provided on Hagar Drive between Steinhart and McLaughlin.

Affected Bicycle Circulation

Bookstore Area - Hagar Drive

Hagar Drive between Steinhart and McLaughlin will be open to cyclists traveling northbound on the one-way road during the Bookstore/Graduate Commons construction period. Cyclists wanting to travel Southbound on Hagar between Steinhart and McLaughlin can walk bicycles on the pedestrian path.

Affected Transit Circulation

Campus Shuttles & Disability Van Service

All Day and Night Shuttle routes and schedules will be modified to accommodate the one-way portion of Hagar Drive. Levels of service and areas served by shuttles will remain the same. The shuttle stop at Baytree, Cowell and the Whole Earth will remain open; the Crown South stop will be closed. Disability Van Service will not be affected.

The Jitney and The Fremont BART Connector Services

Beginning September 1, 1998, The Jitney and The Fremont BART Connector will pick-up and drop-off passengers at the UCSC Applied Sciences Shuttle stop on the Southside of McLaughlin Drive.

Santa Cruz Metro Buses

University #1 bus service will not be affected.
